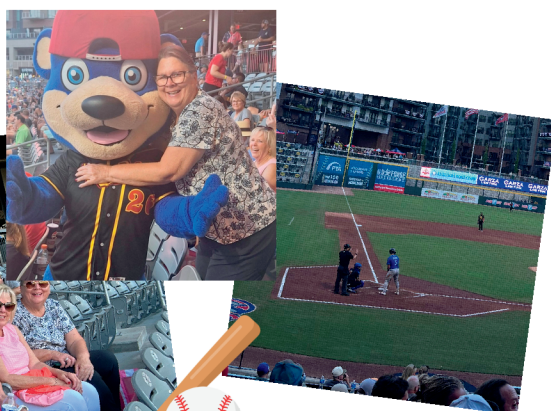
HE-BREWS COFFEE BRIGADE
